

Montana TBF State Team



The Montana Bass Federation

Will form a 12 angler team composed of 6 Boaters and 6 Co-Anglers that will represent Montana in the TBF Semi-Finals.

This tournament will pair the Montana Team VS the Idaho State Team to have a fish-off to be held September 23-24 on Noxon Reservoir, Montana. The top boater and top co-angler from each state will qualify to fish in the TBF National Championship.

Tournament

Format - Montana TBF qualifiers consist of 2 tournaments in 2017.

NOXON RESERVOIR, QUALIFIER June 3-4 Trout Creek/Lakeside Lodge

COEUR D'ALENE, QUALIFIER July 8-9 Harrison, ID

**Boater Entry Fee: \$200 (70% Payback)
Co-Angler Entry Fee: \$100 (70% Payback) Optional
Big Fish Pot \$20 (100% Payback) Paid out to the Biggest
Bass of tournament to Boater and Co-Angler**

- Fees are per tournament. The combined score of both tournaments will determine the 6 boaters and 6 co-anglers to make up the 12 person team.
- This is a Boater/Co-Angler format meaning the boater shall have full control of the operations of the boat and shall make all decisions having to do with operations and locations fished. The Co-angler shall fish from the rear deck of the boat.
- Check-in and registration meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. the day preceding the tournament. Drawings held at 7:00 p.m. If unable to attend meeting must talk to tournament director in advance.
- Saturday tournament time is safelight to 3:00 P.M. Sunday tournament time is safelight to 2:00 P.M.
- Pre-fishing and Water Closures - There will be no off-limits period for the tournaments. There will be one official pre-fish day to be held the Friday prior to each event. All boats must be off the tournament waters by 5:00 P.M. day prior to the Tournament.
